A member of the Reset180 Speakers Bureau will have solid speaking/presentation skills and use those skills to provide awareness and prevention training to groups throughout Northern Virginia.

- Familiarize yourself with the 101 Presentation and speaker's script.
- Adhere to the scheduled time requested for the speaking presentation.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Be passionate about the plight of victims trapped in human trafficking and have a desire to see human trafficking eradicated
- Desire to spread awareness and prevention methods to the community and be comfortable speaking to an audience with prepared remarks (presentation is provided)
- Have the goal of accepting four or more speaking assignments throughout the year;
 approximately one per quarter.
- Attend a train the trainer
- Attend one Human Trafficking Awareness presentation at the Reset180 office/Resource Center
- Give one Human Trafficking Awareness presentation at the Reset180 office/Resource Center
- Use your contacts and spheres of influence to find speaking opportunities (assistance with scheduling and event planning will be provided);
- Minimum 21 years of age
- Must be willing to use own cell phone, computer, and transportation
- Must download and use the Reset180 communication app
- Submit and pay for an online background check: currently \$18.50 (This is because we work with victims of crime, all our volunteers must go through a criminal background check)
- Sign mandatory volunteer forms
- Adhere to Reset180 policies and procedures outlined in the Volunteer Manual
